Environmental Victory Aquaculture Site Adjacent Marine Protected Area Successfully Fought Off

A controversial aquaculture site proposed at Little Musquash, just outside the boundary of the Musquash Marine Protected Area (MPA), will not go ahead due to concerns and uncertainties over tidal currents, which could carry discharges directly into the MPA and adjacent fishing areas. The site application was opposed by environmental and conservation groups, local fishermen, community organizations, Atlantic salmon conservation groups, and adjacent land owners.

“This is a big victory for the Bay of Fundy, wild salmon stocks, and all those who worked for the last 10 years to establish the only Marine Protected Area in the Bay of Fundy” said Fundy Baykeeper, David Thompson.
