An environmental training workshop for Bay of Fundy Shoreline Stewards was held by Fundy Baykeeper on Saturday, May 3, in St. Andrews. The workshop, attended by 20 participants, was followed by a beach cleanup near Pagen Point. Shoreline Stewards discovered and cleaned up some large pieces of aquaculture piping and debris, in addition to a collection of plastic jugs, wrappers, and pieces of rope. A large aquaculture cage was observed stranded and breaking up in the intertidal area nearby. Local Shoreline Stewards will be contacting Department of Natural Resources and the Salmon Growers Association to take responsibility for removal and disposal of the aquaculture cage as it will require boats or heavy equipment.
