For large aquaculture debris, industrial equipment and other large material encountered on the beach or inner tidal area, contact Department of Agriculture and Aquaculture, 506-755-4000, Department of Natural Resources (Crown Lands Branch), 1-888-312-5600. If the debris is aquaculture related, you may also contact the New Brunswick Salmon Growers Association, 506-755-3526.

Illegal shoreline dumping should be reported to the New Brunswick Department of Environment, 658-2558.

NB Department of Natural Resources (Crown Lands Branch) 1-888-312-5600: Regarding problems or questions about **land owned by the province, including: the inner tidal area and the sea bed.**

Report any **illegal shootings of marine mammals** to Fisheries and Oceans Canada (Conservation and Protection Branch), 636-4831.

If any **unusual or rare species** of bird, fish or animal is found dead on the beach or shoreline, immediately collect and freeze. Contact the NB Museum, Natural Science Department, for identification 506-643-2300.

If you encounter a dead whale washed up on the beach, contact Fundy Baykeeper, 694-8780, and the New Brunswick Museum, 643-2300, immediately.
